We will be following up with you in person each day when you arrive to inquire if there have been any changes to your answers to the questions above.



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Informed consent form for volunteers of Pride Stables

We are in this together! Your support to ensure that we can provide an AWESOME camp experience is so VERY APPRECIATED! We can't do this without YOU!

Our primary concern is the health and safety of our participants (riders/campers, volunteers – YOU!) and staff. Please read this carefully and let us know if you have any questions.

Risks associated with COVID-19

You understand that by participating in volunteering at Pride Stables you are assuming the risk of exposure to COVID-19 (or other public health risks). We will practice and encourage physical distancing at Pride Stables whenever possible however due to the nature of our program, you may be in close contact with other participants (riders/campers/support workers/other volunteers/staff) which may increase the risk of COVID-19 transmission.

Our commitment to minimize risk of exposure

Pride Stables has taken the following steps for our awesome volunteers to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19.

- All participants (riders/campers/support workers/volunteers/staff) will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms & risk prior to participating in programming at Pride Stables.
- If you answer *yes* to any screening question you will NOT be permitted to volunteer.
- Staff/volunteers will be wearing a face covering for all active volunteering activities.
- Regular handwashing by all participants including campers is expected and encouraged.
- Smaller groups have been organized for campers & volunteers.
- Frequent disinfection of high-touch surfaces & areas like washrooms will be completed.
- Camp structure/riding timelines have been adjusted to allow for smaller groups and procedures like disinfection of tack & equipment (saddles, cross-ties, brushes etc.)
- Soap and hand-sanitizer will be readily available.
- Cleaning/sanitization will take place during the day, at the end of day, and at the end of each week of camp.

Your responsibilities to minimize your exposure

As a volunteer, you agree to take certain precautions which will help keep everyone safe.

- You will only arrive for volunteering if you are symptom free.
- You will review and complete Pride Stables' screening questionnaire & submit it to Pride Stables before you begin your first day of volunteering. Each consecutive day thereafter you will be asked if anything has changed.
- You will inform us immediately if, at any time during the course of volunteering, you can answer yes to any of the Pride Stables screening questions.
- We appreciate that some of you are either dropped off or take public transit BUT NO volunteers are permitted on the property early. If you arrive early you will wait until a staff member is available in the driveway to screen and acknowledge you. If you are driving and arrive early, please park & stay in your car.
- You will wash your hands with soap & water when you first arrive at the stables, prior to entering the barn, after leaving the barn, and regularly during your time at the stables. There is an outdoor handwashing area around the corner from the main barn doors.
- When you are not able to wash your hands (preferred), you will use alcohol-based hand sanitizer (available on site).
- You will try not to touch your face/mouth/nose/eyes with your hands. If you do you will immediately wash or sanitize your hands.
- You will wear a face shield when you are actively volunteering. (Shields available, \$5ea).
- When you are not actively volunteering and not able to physically distance, you must wear a mask. This includes while in the barn. (Bring own mask or available for \$2 each).
- Maintain a physical distance from others where appropriate & possible.
- Do not enter areas dedicated & marked for campers (e.g. top of barn, camper picnic table areas).
- You will only enter the barn if you are required to be there or are instructed to be there (i.e. ONLY leaders in the barn to groom/tack). This is to minimize the number of people in enclosed indoor spaces.
- Please do not wander the property.
- We have designated outdoor volunteer picnic tables where side-walkers & other volunteers will wait. In the event of rain, we will provide appropriate protected spaces.
- Follow signs (e.g. STOP/Staff Only), directions & instructions of staff and any designated volunteers of Pride Stables.
- If you or any resident of your home has had close contact with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 you will let us know.
- If you or a resident of your home test positive for COVID-19 you will immediately let us know and will not attend your volunteering shift.

If we all work together we can stay safe and provide an awesome experience for our campers and ourselves! **Thank You!** Again and again, we can't do it without YOU!

Your confidentiality in case of infection

If you have had any exposure to anyone at Pride Stables who subsequently tests positive for the coronavirus, we will notify you immediately so that you can take appropriate precautions.

Pride Stables is keeping attendance and screening records during the COVID-19 pandemic. If you or any participants/volunteers/staff test positive for COVID-19 we may be required to release this information to public health officials for the purposes of contact tracing. We will only provide the minimum information necessary for their data collection. With this consent form you are agreeing that we may do so without an additional signed release.
